On 16 June 2016 you emailed the Ministry requesting, under the Official Information Act 1982, the following information:

- 1. How much has your organisation spent, for each year, subsidising acupuncture treatment for staff members.*
- 2. Are there any other "alternative" treatments that your organisation subsidises for employees? If so, how much has been spent per year on each? For this question, "alternative treatments" includes, but is not restricted to, chiropractic, osteopathy and homeopathy*

The Ministry is committed to the prevention and management of workplace injury and illness. Managers are actively involved in recovery, rehabilitation and workplace return to work programmes. Wellnz is contracted to help administer and manage this process, this enables the Ministry to successfully self-manage staff workplace injuries and reduce their impact. Wellnz, on behalf of the Ministry funds approved treatments and medical interventions for injured staff which are prescribed under the Accident Compensation Act 2001.

The table below provides the total cost associated to acupuncture, chiropractor and osteopath treatments for the past five years.
