Thank you for your email on 15 July 2016 requesting the following information:

the number of schools on the N4L managed network which have had their servers compromised or otherwise been hacked in the past year. If possible, I'd like a monthly breakdown.

Your request has been considered under the Official Information Act (the Act).

N4L does not control, nor have visibility over schools' internal hardware, including servers. N4L does not collect and is therefore unable to provide the data you have requested. Your request is not able to be responded to, under s18 (g) of the Act.
