## OFFICIAL INFORMATION ACT REQUEST

I refer to your official information request received by the Ministry for Primary Industries (MPI) on 16 August 2016 asking for all catch per unit of effort (CPUE) reports for Cray 6-7-8; all rules and information regarding the number of craypots around coastal towns and camping grounds; and all rules and information regarding the number of commercial pots in any given area.

The latest Rock Lobster Fisheries Plenary Report published in November 2015, summarises fishery, biological, stock assessment and stock status information for the two main species of Rock Lobster found in New Zealand, the spiny red rock lobster (*Jasus edwardsii*) and the packhorse rock lobster (*Sagmariasus verreauxi*). This report includes CPUE information for the CRA 6, 7 and 8 rock lobster fisheries.

The primary measure that is used to sustainably manage commercial rock lobster catch is through the setting of an annual Total Allowable Commercial Catch. There are no restrictions on the number of commercial pots used for targeting rock lobster in New Zealand. However, there are voluntary commercial restrictions that are followed in some areas of the coastline where there is overlap with recreational fishers in summer months. For instance, commercial fishers voluntarily do not fish the Gisborne and East Cape parts of the CRA 3 fishery from 1 September to 15 January.
