## Official Information Act request relating to Ōtākaro Ltd

I refer to your Official Information Act 1982 (the Act) request received on 7 August 2016. You requested the following:

"...all information relating to consideration as to whether Otakaro Ltd. (a Crown company) should be subject to:

A. The Public Records Act

B. The Official Information Act."

Ōtākaro Limited was incorporated under the Public Finance Act 1989 as a Schedule 4A company. As such, it automatically became subject to the Ombudsmen Act 1975 (see Part 2 of Schedule 1) and, correspondingly, the Official Information Act (see section 2 definition of "organisation").

Whether an entity is subject to the Public Records Act 2005 (PRA) depends on whether it is a "public office" as defined in section 4 of the PRA. The Chief Archivist has issued a recommendation that Ōtākaro Limited is not a public office and I enclose a copy of that recommendation for your information. We do not hold any further documents on this matter.
