## **Purpose**

The purpose of this memorandum is to introduce the submissions on the 2014/2015 Annual Plan, hear those submitters who wish to speak to their written submission and to recommend any changes to the Plan.

#### Recommendations

### **Background**

Pursuant to the *Local Government Act* 2002, the Council has prepared its 2014/2015 *Annual Plan Statement of Proposal*. This document is required to go through a public consultation process pursuant to section 83 of the *Local Government Act* 2002.

#### **Discussion**

The 2014/2015 Annual Plan Statement of Proposal was adopted on 24 February 2014 and publicly notified as being available for submissions on 15 March 2014. The submissions closed on 22 April 2014.

A total of 51 submissions have been received. A schedule of those submitters who wish to present their submissions is attached to this memorandum.

A summary of each of the issues raised in the submissions is separately attached. The summary includes officer's comments and any amendment recommendations. A copy of each of the submissions is also separately attached.

The process at this meeting is to hear all those submitters who wish to present their submission, to consider and make recommendations on all of the submissions and finally, to adopt the amended 2014/2015 Annual Plan. It is proposed to set the rates for 2014/2015 at the 20 May 2014 Ordinary Meeting.

#### **Decision-making considerations**

Part 6 (Planning, decision-making and accountability) of the *Local Government Act* 2002 has been considered and documented in the preparation of this agenda item. The recommendations made in this item comply with the decision-making obligations of the *Act*.
