- The use of a PIR to activate the system means that it will only turn on when there is movement in the specified location

## Protecting a Grand Old Lady

Massey Grandstand in Papakura, Auckland, had been a target for graffiti artists and arsonists for a long period of time. In August of 2009, youths used straw to light a fire that nearly destroyed the historic grandstand that was once sited at Eden Park.
