By way of background; the development propose is for a new Environment. It is a similar proposal to that which was submitted in 2011/12 (LUC 841). The main differences are a slightly different vegetation to accommodate a slightly wider driveway. An Arborist have advised that the trees to be removed are subject to appropriate replanting of native vegetation.
