## Official Information Act request

Thank you for your Official Information Act (the Act) request, received on 20 October 2016. You requested information on the following:

"Government papers that specifically make reference to options for delivery of Whānau Ora.

Please supply the following information under the official Information Act (OIA)/Local Government Official Information and meetings Act (LGOIMA):

All options papers, Cabinet papers and Ministerial briefing papers in the time period 2010 – 2012 that make specific reference to options (such as commissioning) for delivery of Whānau Ora."

A substantial amount of material is potentially in scope of your request.

In order to review this information to identify the information that is in scope, Te Puni Kōkiri would need to dedicate a significant portion of its resource, which would have a considerable effect on our fulfilment of day-to-day operations.

I am therefore refusing this part of your request under section 18(f) of the Act as the information requested cannot be made available without substantial collation or research. In making my decision I have considered whether extending the deadline for the response or charging for the response would enable us to meet your request.
