Agreement Conditions – No alteration to event details as per your email dated 19 October 2015. Display can viewed prior to use.

Conditions:

- 1. That resource consent from the Auckland Council has been granted.
- 2. Only the approved handler in charge, and those listed as being under there direct supervision, must attend and are to be engaged with the firing and handling, on site.
- 3. All product manufacturers/distributors instructions to be adhered to
- 4. The wind speed within the discharge area does not exceed, with the exception of occasional gusts, 30 km/hr.
- 5. No burning fragments fall within an area where a member of the public are present.
- 6. All spectators must be kept well clear of fireworks at all times during the display.
- A procedure be put in place to evacuate the public away from the display area, should this be needed.
- 8. Suitable, in-service, first aid firefighting equipment (e.g. fire extinguishers, knapsack pumps, etc) are immediately available at the firing points and any other appropriate location, along with trained personnel to operate them.
- 9. Potential areas of vegetation fire, in the expected area of pyrotechnic landing, should be managed prior to firing. to avert accidental ignition (e.g. grass areas to be mown; dry gardens and vegetation wet down).
- 10. No Chinese lanterns are to be used.

- 11. Examination of site and surrounds is to be carried out post-firing
- 12. A phone must be available to contact fire or other emergency services (Dial 111).
- 13. Unobstructed access to the area must be maintained for emergency vehicles.
- 14. The New Zealand Fire Service Communication Centre notified prior to event (Phone: 09 486 7648 and place an 'Advised Event')

The Area Commander for Waitemata Fire Area hereby agrees to the above display in accordance with the Hazardous Substances (Classes 1 to 5 Controls) Regulations 2001, Section 39 (2).

The agreement is subject to the above 'agreement conditions'. If such conditions are not Released under the Official Infloring met, or continued to be met then this agreement is deemed to be withdrawn and you must seek a new approval from the Area Commander.


