I refer to your email of 11 November requesting the following information under the Official Information Act 1982 (OIA):


1. *Please supply all agreements, including but not limited to Memorandums of Understanding, letters of understanding, contracts etc., between the Ministry for Culture and Heritage and Ngā Taonga Sound & Vision (New Zealand Archive of Film, Television and Sound Ngā Taonga Whitiāhua Me Ngā Taonga Kōrero) from 2014 onwards.*
2. *Please supply all reports, proposals, plans from 2014 onwards that have been either been received by the Ministry, authored by the Ministry or commissioned by the Ministry in relation to Ngā Taonga Sound & Vision (New Zealand Archive of Film, Television and Sound Ngā Taonga Whitiāhua Me Ngā Taonga Kōrero).*

The Ministry estimates that the scope of your request covers around 100 documents. As it currently stands your request may be refused under section 18(f) of the OIA as to provide a response would require a substantial amount of research and collation.

Under section 18(B) of the OIA the Ministry invites you to refine your request so that we may be able to provide a response. In particular, if you are able to specify what exact documents you are seeking this will help us assess your request.

You have the right, under section 28(3) of the OIA, to ask an Ombudsman to review my response to your request.
