Re: Importation of medicine - Truvision products - second importation

Medsafe is the regulatory authority responsible for administering the medicines legislation in New Zealand.

On 29 June 2016 we sent you a letter regarding the importation of 930 capsules of Truvision Weight and Energy containing the prescription medicine oxedrine (synephrine). We have detained the medicines. The reference for this consignment is This consignment contains 58 flatpacks each containing a blisterpack of 15 capsules. There is also a box containing 60 capsules. The total amount of capsules is 930.

We have ascertained that a second consignment of Truvision Weight and Energy products addressed to you that contains the prescription medicine oxedrine (synephrine) have been imported. We have detained the medicines. The reference for this consignment is This consignment contains 82 flatpacks each containing a blisterpack of 15 capsules. There is also a box containing 60 capsules. The total amount of capsules is 1290.

The total quantity for imported consignments and and see 2220 capsules.

It is unlawful to sell, distribute or advertise these medicines. The penalty for doing so is a fine not exceeding \$20,000 or a term of imprisonment not exceeding \$20,000 [s20 Medicines Act 1981].

It is unlawful to import prescription medicines into New Zealand without a reasonable excuse (s43 Medicines Act 1981 "The Act").

Please contact me to discuss these importations. If I do not hear from you by 29 July 2016 I will seize the medicine listed above in consignment pursuant to s63(2)(i) of the Act.

I advise that section 65(1) of The Act provides that any person who has an interest in the items seized may, within seven days of notification of seizure, make application to the District Court to apply for an order -

(a) that the seizure be disallowed and that the article be returned or otherwise be made available to him.

(b) that the Crown shall pay to him such sum by way of value of the substance or article resulting from its seizure, detention, or removal as the Crown thinks fit.

I further advise that if no application for disallowance is received within seven days of the seizure then the articles become property of the Crown.

RE: Importation and distribution of medicines + Truvision products

This letter relates to the importation and distribution of Truvision products in New Zealand that we believe contravene the Medicines Act 1981.

Importation of products

On 17 June 2016 the NZ Customs Service referred to Medsafe five boxes containing a total of 63 flat packs. Two of the boxes are addressed to and the other three to the five boxes there are a total of 61 blue flat packs, one box of 60 capsules of Truvision Weight and Energy and a box of 60 capsules of tryFIX.

The flat packs are mostly blue in colour and possibly generation 1. I understand that other flat packs coloured green are generation 2.

The blue flat packs contain a blisterpack of 15 blue capsules (truFIX) and a blisterpack of 15 green capsules Tru WEIGHT & ENERGY).

Section (2)(b)(ii)

The products have been detained by us pending enquiries with you, the distributor in NZ Ltd and Truvision in the United States.

Discussion with you regarding the importation

Thank you for the telephone conversation that we have had regarding this matter that started on 23 June 2016. You have advised me of the following:

- See the second is you daughter and you live together. You have spoken to me on behalf of your daughter also.
- You and your daughter have imported the Truvision products for the purpose of sale. You have sold these products in the past and also take some for personal use.

- You ordered the products direct from the Truvision website by logging in, making the order and paying using your credit card.
- You have advertised and sold the Truvision products using facebook
- You are not aware that the Truvision breached the Medicines Act 1981.

Bitter Orange Extract (synephrine 30%)

The Supplemented Facts panel on the flat pack for the tru WEIGHT & ENERGY product states "Bitter Orange Extract (synephrine 30%). Synephrine is also known as oxedrine. Oxedrine in medicines containing more than 30 milligrams per recommended daily dose is a prescription medicine.

Our independent testing has established that each capsule contains 30mg of Synephrine

The labelling on the product is: "Suggested use: take one of each capsule before breakfast and again in the early afternoon". This indicates the recommended daily dose is two capsules and therefore the recommended daily intake would be greater than 30mg milligrams of oxedrine a day. This means that the product would be considered to be a prescription medicine as the recommended daily dose is over 30 milligrams.

Our testing of the tru WEIGHT & ENERGY green capsules from the generation 1 one week sample pack established that each capsule contained approximately 30mg of Oxedrine (Synephrine) per capsule (ESR report PHA 16124/1).

Additionally, the ingredient exedrine is included in schedule 1 of the Medicines Regulations 1984 and therefore any product that contains this medicine is considered to be for a therapeutic purpose and would be a general sale medicine if present in doses below those specified for a prescription medicine. For this product to be sold, distributed or advertised in New Zealand the product must be consented by the Minister of Health pursuant to section 20 of the Medicines Act 1981.

Our opinion is that this product is a prescription medicine. I recommend that you do not advertise, sell or distribute this medicine.

Therapeutic Claim

The advertising on the blue flat pack uses the words "Lose Body Fat". This wording is considered to be a therapeutic claim and therefore the product is for a therapeutic purpose.

Compliance with the Medicines Act 1981

I have contacted the importer and advised them that importing the Truvision product for the purpose of advertising, sale and distribution breaches the Medicines Act 1981.

Any person or company importing, advertising and selling any of the Truvision products identified in our correspondence including generation 1 and 2 products I believe will potentially breach sections 17, 18, 20 and 43 of the Act. This is outlined in previous correspondence.

We are aware that Truvision products are still being sold in New Zealand. I intend to contact known sellers and advise them that they cannot advertise and sell the products identified in this letter and other correspondence and if they do so they will potentially be breaching the Medicines Act 1981. Advertising includes facebook and websites.

It is my opinion that you were supplied sufficient information in the correspondence prior to this letter that would enable you to reasonably establish that the products that are continuing to be distributed in NZ are likely to breach the Act.

Any further non-compliant Truvision product that enters New Zealand that we believe is in breach of the Act are is likely to be the subject to regulatory action which may include seizure.

Current detention of imported product

For the reasons above, I can not release the imported 5 boxes of Truvision product to you. With your consent I can have the product destroyed.

Alternatively, in this instance only, I will allow the product to be returned to the sender. If this was the case, you would need to advise Truvision and any costs would need to be covered by yourself or Truvision. Once the product is sent from NZ and in the postal or freight forwarding system, Medsafe would not have any responsibility for the boxes and contents.

Action required

I <u>strongly recommend</u> that you cease sending this non-compliant product to New Zealand as any person, company or entity involved with any illicit advertising, selling and distribution of Truvision products that are not compliant with the Medicines Act 1981 may be liable.

Once again. Fencourage you to review all of your products and ensure that they are all compliant with NZ law of you intend to market them in New Zealand.

Good afternoon

As discussed earlier, we are of the opinion that the TruVision Gen 1 Product is a prescription medicine.

Our enquiries suggest that the synephrine (oxedrine) in each capsule, taken at the recommended daily dose (two capsules per day), exceeds 30 milligrams.

Oxedrine is a prescription medicine (in New Zealand) when the recommended daily dose is more than 30 milligrams.

In view of this we advise that you no longer import, possess, sell or distribute the product.

Section 43 (1) of the Medicines Act 1981 states that: 'No person shall, without reasonable excuse, import, procure, receive, store, use, or otherwise bake in his possession, any prescription medicine'
