Official Information Act request

We refer to your original request dated 4 March 2017, made under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act), asking for information relating to a media article about ACC's Transformation programme. We asked you to specify exactly what information you are seeking from ACC. On 20 March 2017, you reworded your request as follows:

"...with regard to the \$450 million project, has the ACC had a first anniversary report compiled to satisfy stake holders that the objectives are on track etc"

Thank you for your assistance by providing us with the clarification above. The information you have requested is publically available.

Firstly to assist your understanding of the objectives of ACC's Transformation Programme, we have included a hyperlink to a Cabinet Paper that has been made publically available by the Minister for ACC. As is the case with all major government projects, the Transformation Programme has been monitored and reported on by the Treasury. Please note, the Transformation Programme is discussed on page 45 of this document.
