Official Information Act Request for the Prime Minister's Diary from 3 to 9 September 2012

I refer to your official information request of 14 September 2012 for "a copy of the Minster's diary for the 3rd to the 9th of September 2012, including: the names of any persons that the Minister is meeting with, including the names of any organizations that they were representing; the subject of any meeting the Minister had.

In the case of meeting public servants or private constituents the disclosure of names is not necessary. "Briefing with Ministry of Education Officials" or "Meeting with Constituent" would work fine.

If the subject of any meeting cannot be disclosed under s6 or s9 I would still like to know the identity of those who were met with."

Although not applicable in relation to the date range for the diary information you have requested, it should be noted that information held by the Rt Hon John Key is only deemed to be "official information" if it is held in his capacity as a Minister of the Crown. Information any Minister holds relating to engagements, such as meetings with constituents, which are undertaken as a Member of Parliament is, therefore, not official information.

Enclosed is a copy of the diary of the Prime Minister from Monday 3 September 2012 to Sunday 9 September 2012. It should be noted that the diary of the Prime Minister held by this Office does not accurately record all engagements the Prime Minister has undertaken, as it is not necessarily updated when the situation changes, particularly when he has been attending engagements outside the Office. In this case, we have noted that on Tuesday 4 September 2012, engagements made in Christchurch were cancelled due to flight cancellations.

Some names and contact details have been redacted from the diary under section 9(2)(a) of the Official Information Act as withholding the information is necessary "to protect the privacy of natural persons, including that of deceased natural persons." No public interest in releasing the withheld information has been identified that would be sufficient to override the reasons for withholding it. A small amount of information has also been withheld under section 6(d) of the Official Information Act as the making available of that information would be likely "to endanger the safety of any person."

You are entitled to ask the Ombudsman to review this decision under section 28(3) of the Official Information Act.
