## **Official Information Act Request**

The New Zealand Security Intelligence Service adheres to the New Zealand Information Security Manual (NZISM) for air gapping networks. The NZISM details the processes and controls essential for the protection of all New Zealand Government information and systems. I decline to provide you with a copy the NZISM under section 18(d) of the OIA, on the grounds that it is publicly available on the Government Communications Security Bureau's website [www.gcsb.govt.nz].
