I refer to your email of 21 March in which you requested:


For the periods 2014, 2015, 2016 and for the period to date of 2017:

- *Please provide details of any prosecutions the Police has undertaken under the Civil Aviation Act, against operator(s) of RPAS*
- *Please also provide details of any other legal actions the Police has undertaken under the Civil Aviation Act, against operator(s) of RPAS*
- *Similarly, please also detail any prosecutions or other legal actions the Police has undertaken under any other legislation, against operator(s) of RPAS – for example, Privacy laws.*

I have considered your request in accordance with the Official Information Act 1982. Police does not hold sufficient detail to identify prosecutions specific to RPAS relating to the Civil Aviation Act or Privacy laws. From reviewing the information obtained the majority of prosecutions appear to relate to laser strike incidents and threats.

If you are not satisfied with my response to your request you have the right to complain to the Office of the Ombudsmen and seek an investigation and review of my decision.
