Dear Tony

Request made under the Official Information Act 1982

Thank you for your email of 7 April 2017 requesting the following information from the NZ Transport Agency under the Official Information Act (the Act) 1982:

- 1) Can I please have a copy of the "long list of scenarios"?*
- 2) Can I please have a copy of the analysis used to "filter" this "long list of scenarios to create a draft short list of scenarios"?*
- 3) Can I please have a copy of the process used to create the long list of scenarios and then filter them to a draft short list of scenarios?*
- 4) Can I please have a copy of the agenda, minutes, attendee list and also any supporting information presented for the meeting (or meetings) where the final short list of scenarios was decided?*
- 5) Can I please have a copy of the documentation that describes the short list of scenarios in detail including any option costs/benefits that are held?*

On 27 April 2017 we notified you that we had extended your request to enable the necessary consultations to take place.

In response to questions one, two and three, I can advise that the long list of scenarios for the *Let's Get Wellington Moving* (LGWM) initiative will be publicly available on the programme website by 23 June 2017, along with details of the initial analysis and the rationale used to create the long list. Therefore, I am refusing questions one to three of your request under section 18(d) of the Act as the information requested is or will soon be publicly available.

In answer to your questions four and five the final short list of scenarios for the LGWM initiative has not yet been determined, as the LGWM programme needs to complete testing and analysis of some of the individual interventions that could be within each of the scenarios. I am therefore refusing questions four and five of your request under section 18(e) of the Official Information Act 1982, as the document alleged to contain the information requested does not exist.

Under section 28(3) of the Act, you have the right to apply to an Ombudsman for an investigation and review of the decision to refuse your request. The email address is www.ombudsman.parliament.nz/.
