## Information Request - Avondale laundromat fire

I refer to your request for the call-log and appliance response/movement information for the fire that occurred at the laundromat premises at 10 Copsey Place, Avondale, on 20 April 2017.

Your request has been processed under the Official Information Act 1982 (**OIA**) and a decision made to release information to you. The information you have asked for is contained in the *attached* SMS incident report for this fire.

Please note that some personal information has been redacted from the incident report in order to protect the privacy of natural persons, in accordance with section 9(2)(a) of the OIA. The New Zealand Fire Service Commission (**NZFS**) does not consider that this interest is outweighed by other considerations which render it desirable, in the public interest, to make the redacted information available.

If you are dissatisfied with the decision made on your request, you have the right to seek a review through the Office of the Ombudsman in accordance with section 28(3) of the OIA. Information about how to seek a review is available at www.ombudsman.parliament.nz or freephone 0800 802 602.

Finally, I note that this is one of several requests you have made in recent months for information relating to incidents and appliance movements in the Auckland area. If you have a particular interest in aspects of the NZFS's operations, then it may be that there is a more efficient way to provide you with that information than through a sequence of requests in relation to specific incidents.
