Official Information Act Request

I refer to your request dated 22 June 2017, pursuant to the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act), seeking:

“how much total income was generated across New Zealand each year from Road User Charges (RUC), for each of the years beginning 2013, 2014, 2015 and 2016”.

The Ministry of Transport (the Ministry) already releases RUC revenue information publicly through the Revenue Monitoring Snapshots it produces each quarter.

These snapshots are on the Ministry’s external website:



However, the RUC revenue is reported on a financial year basis (1 July to 30 June year) instead of a calendar year basis as you have requested. Therefore, please find the RUC revenue for the calendar year 2013, 2014, 2015 and 2016 in Table 1 below:
