Dear Mr Walker

On 26 June 2017, you emailed the Ministry requesting, under the Official Information Act 1982, the following information:

- *The most recent statistics on the amount of people under the age of 19 (or their caregivers) receiving jobseeker support, the orphans benefit, youth payment or the unsupported Child's benefit?*

The following five tables attached show the number of dependents of clients, and the number of clients aged 18 years and under in receipt of a benefit as at 30 June 2017:

- Table 1 shows the number of clients aged 18 years and under in receipt of a benefit broken down by benefit type.
- Tables 2 and 3 show the number of dependent children for clients aged 18 years or under and clients aged 19 years or over respectively, in receipt of a main benefit or Young Parent Payment.
- Table 4 shows the number of dependent children for clients receiving Orphan's Benefit or Unsupported Child's Benefit.
- Table 5 shows the number of dependent clients and corresponding dependent children which are in receipt of Orphan's Benefit or Unsupported Child's Benefit.

Young Parent Payment provides clients aged between 16 and 19 years who have a dependent child. Clients receiving the Young Parent Payment are required to be enrolled in a full-time course of secondary or tertiary education; additionally the Ministry provides support with budgeting and parenting education programmes. This support provides young parents with the skills and abilities to gain financial independence, employment and parenting skills.
