OFFICIAL INFORMATION ACT REQUEST

I refer to your official information request on 30 June relating to the legality of taking fish or marine life from the Lyttelton Harbour area.

A mätaitai reserve came into effect in portions of Lyttelton Harbour on 20 July 2017. A map of this mätaitai reserve can be found at http://fs.fish.govt.nz/Page.aspx?pk=128&tk=593

Mätaitai reserves recognise the special relationship between tangata whenua and the importance for customary food gathering. A mätaitai reserve is established under fisheries regulations and is an identified traditional fishing ground.

Non-commercial fishing is not restricted in a mätaitai, however commercial fishing is prohibited. Any non-commercial fishing that occurs in a mätaitai is still required to occur within recreational bag and size limits, and fishing gear regulations.
