OFFICIAL INFORMATION ACT REQUEST

Thank you for your requests via email, made under the Official Information Act 1982, dated 7 July 2017 and 19 July 2017.

On 7 July 2017, you have asked:

1) "Please state what applications for consent or permission DOC needs to make for aerial 1080 operations over forests on the Coromandel peninsula in 2017? Please list the applications by forest."

Public Conservation administered land requires consent by the District Health Board under 'Permission for Use Of Vertebrate Toxic Agent(s)'. The permission is issued by the Health Protection Officer of the Waikato District Health Board.

Moehau, Papakai and Otahu require a Department of Conservation (DOC) application for consent and is an internal auditing tool. Mataora and Mahakirau are private properties and do not require a DOC application for consent.

On 19 July 2017, you have asked:

 'Please provide copies of all applications and permissions for aerial 1080 operations on Moehau, Papakai, Otahu and Mataora forests of the Coromandel peninsula this year 2017 as they come to hand.'
