I refer to your email dated 22 July 2017 where you asked;


I would like to know if the New Zealand police uses dash cams in their vehicles to record events, traffic stops and other incidents.

If so, What model of dash cam system is used and the cost of install of such system?

I can confirm New Zealand Police do not use dash cams in their vehicles, and therefore the second part of your request is refused under section 18(e) of the Official Information Act 1982 as the information does not exist.

You have the right, under section 28(3) of the Official Information Act 1982, to ask the Ombudsman to review my decision if you are not satisfied with the way i have responded to your request.
