### **OFFICIAL INFORMATION ACT 1982 REQUEST**

On 25 July 2017, you submitted a request for information under the Official Information Act 1982 (“the Act”) through the FYI website, with the intention that it would be received by Tāmaki Regeneration Company (TRC)<sup>1</sup>.

It appears that the FYI website held an outdated email address for TRC at the time you submitted that request. I can confirm that a check of TRC’s records shows that your request was, in fact, never received by TRC.

On 25 September 2017, a member of the public alerted TRC to the fact that there were several requests on the FYI website that were intended for TRC, but did not appear to have been acknowledged or responded to.

At that time, TRC checked the FYI website and became aware of your request. For the purposes of the Act, your request is considered as being received on 25 September 2017.

Your request was for the following information:

*“I would like to make a request in line with s12 of the Official Information Act 1982.*

*I am interested in how TRC Ltd has undertaken consultation with HNZN tenants since TRC was established in 2012.*

*I am interested in the philosophy and strategy of TRC's consultation processes as well as a record of what activities occurred and when.*

*I therefore request documents from TRC that best capture my request.”*

Your request is being considered in accordance with the provisions of the Act. TRC will endeavour to respond to your request as soon as possible and, in any event, no later than 24 October 2017, being 20 working days after the date your request was received by TRC on 25 September 2017.

If we are unable to respond to your request by then, we will notify you of an extension to that timeframe.
