TRC will replace 2500 social houses in Tāmaki with 7500 social, affordable and private market houses over the next 10 to 15 years. But it's about more than just building houses. TRC has worked closely with the community to put together a set of ideas and actions to make Tāmaki an even better place to be.

These are things like:

- · improving education
- · building warm, modern homes
- attracting and keeping good businesses
- creating local jobs and providing training

This is regeneration. It looks at all of the factors that affect our future, not just some of them.
