2011	Taking of photographs of complainant through their window.	Spoken to by Campus Constable / Proctor.
2012	Sexual assault by non-student visitor to Residential College.	Referred to Police.
2014	Indecent Exposure.	Referred to Police
	Female student assaulted by non-student visitor to Residential College.	Trespassed. Incident referred to Police for follow-up.
2015	Comments of sexual nature made to female student.	Warned by Proctor.
	Allegation of rape.	Removed from Residential College and matter referred to Police.
	Taking photographs of complainant in shower.	Matter handled in-house (Residential College)
	Allegation of sexual attack.	Removed from Residential College and matter referred to Police.
2016	Two males enter room of female resident/boundary issue.	Warned by Proctor.
	Unwanted sexual advances/boundary issue.	Spoken to by Head of College with clear indication of consequences if behaviour was to continue.
	Filming of male while using urinal.	Police involved. Informal diversion. Referred for counselling.
	Male observing student while using urinal.	No offender located.
	Filming of female in bathroom.	Referred to Police, with respondent prosecuted. Suspended from University under Code of Conduct.
	Allegation of rape after blind date.	Reported to Police by complainant. Police investigated with insufficient evidence to progress. Insufficient evidence to progress under Code of Student Conduct. Counselling and academic support provided to the complainant.
2017	Unacceptable attitude/comments towards female sports club members.	Referred to the Proctor's Office. Trespassed from sports club and counselling.
	Historical sexual assault by ex-boyfriend.	Victim did not want to pursue with Police nor under the Student Code of Conduct. Complainant reported the matter seeking counselling with Student Health.
	Female allegedly attacked as she walked home.	Police involved. After reviewing CCTV footage Police advise that the matter will not be progressed.
	Female alleges sexual assault by male student who she had invited into her room.	Police investigated matter. No charges laid.

2017	Inappropriate behaviour on Tinder date. (No assault)	Complainant declined Police involvement. Warned by Proctor's Office. Trespassed.
	Inappropriate touching whilst at licenced premises in City.	Investigated under Code of Conduct. Trespassed from venue, and given community work.
	Unwanted physical contact/boundary issue.	Investigated under Code of Conduct. Counselling and supervision undertaken.
	Male inappropriately touched 7 other males. (2 complain formally, 5 informally)	Complainants declined Police involvement. Investigated under Code of Conduct and Ethical Behaviour Policy. Respondent removed from Residential College and not rehoused. Academic support and counselling offered/provided to all complainants. Respondent received counselling and supervision.
	Unwanted sexual contact, male complainant, female respondent.	Head of College notified, issue resolved. Supervision and counselling undertaken.
	Unwanted physical contact/boundary issue.	Investigated under Code of Conduct. Counselling and supervision undertaken.
	Sexual assault at nightclub.	Matter reported to Police. Male student charged. Matter ongoing.
	Sexual assault and intimate recording.	Complainant declined Police involvement. Complainant supported with counselling and academic support. Matter investigated under Code of Conduct and Ethical Behaviour Policy. Three males excluded from Residential Colleges - all withdrawn from the UoO. Code of Conduct consequence suspended/pending.
	Taking photographs of complainant in shower.	Referred to Police, with respondent prosecuted. Matter ongoing.
