ADVICE OF CONSENT FOR WORK ON ROAD RESERVE TMP PERMIT APPROVAL – DSH38/WAIHI ROAD

Thank you for your application for the above work, within the road reserve at the above location. This letter serves as the Advise of Consent notice for the above works and **Abel Tasman Forestry Services's** previously submitted Health and Safety Plan, including agreement of the submitted Traffic Management Plans from QRS. Please read and ensure the requirements of the New National Code for Utilities in the Transport Corridor are met (copy can be downloaded from the roadshare website www.nzuag.org.nz/roadshare)

For the duration of these works the site shall be under the control of your STMS personnel (Chris McGregor #54250) to ensure on-going Traffic Management compliance and safety.

The following specific requirements detailed below must be observed;

- 48 hours notice is to be given before commencing any work on site, to the Operations Engineer - Roads Mike Hardie 027 539 8669.
- The Contractor shall ensure protection of all services in accordance with the New National Code for Utilities in the Transport Corridor.
- The Contractor must have a copy of the agreed Traffic Management Plan and this signed Advise of Consent notice on site at all times, available for viewing on request.
- Unless specified otherwise (refer item 2 of the Reasonable Conditions), **hours of work are 0700hrs to 1800hrs Monday to Saturday**, provided there is sufficient daylight to render clearly visible a person or equipment at a distance of 120 metres.
- **Any damage to the roadside and/or carriageway (including culverts and crossings) as a result of your operations shall be reinstated to match the existing by the Contractor.**
- **No slash to be left in the water table & any vegetation overhanging the road corridor shall be removed**
- **If necessary, logs may be stockpiled in approved areas temporarily.**
- **Please ensure that all Traffic Management guidelines are followed.**
- The Operations Engineer - Roads must be advised by the Contractor when the site has been cleared and when the work has been completed otherwise *additional charges may be incurred*. The A9: Works Completion Notice can be found on the WDC website. Inspections will take place to ensure road corridor is left in a satisfactory condition.

Please note any this is a permit for Traffic Management and specified activities above, any entranceways onto the Council and NZTA roads need to be approved before work commences.
