

Restraint Minimisation & Safe Practice Flowchart (District)

Decision to restrain patient or use enabler based on patient's behaviour

- Prevent serious harm to self and/or to others
- Facilitate treatment delivery (duty of care)
- Behaviour compromises therapeutic environment (e.g. damage to property)



ASSESS patient and document in clinical record and Restraint Care Plan MIDAS MR1090 V3

- * ASSESS (A = airway, breathing, circulation; S = social & cultural; S = psychological; E = environmental; S = situation; S = safety)
- Communication as required to other multidisciplinary team members using ISBAR (I= introduce yourself; S = situation; B = background; A = assessment; R = recommendation).
- Documentation in the patient's clinical record recording the health professionals involved in the assessment and the less restrictive interventions such as de-escalation or alternative interventions used (e.g. 1:1 time, changing the environment, family (whanau), cultural advisors etc.) and the outcome.
