Official Information Act request – criminal conviction history checks

I refer to your request under the Official Information Act 1982, lodged through www.fyi.org.nz on 12 September 2017, for information about how the Ministry processes and charges for requests from third parties for criminal conviction history reports.

The Ministry is preparing a response to your request. However, due to the volume of information requested, the Ministry cannot reasonably provide a response within the original time limit. Accordingly, I am extending the time for responding to this request by 20 working days under section 15A of the Official Information Act.
