Official Information Act Request

I refer to your request of 11 October 2017, asking for the following information under the Official Information Act 1982, (the Act):

"Please provide the amount of times the ICD-10 codes x60 thru to x84 have been recorded/used for the years 2014, 2015, 2016".

Our response

ACC is unable to provide the information you requested as the read codes you refer to in your request are not used by ACC. Therefore, in line with section 18(e) of the Act, ACC declines your request as the information does not exist.

We note that the codes you refer to are international codes and relate to 'intentional self-harm' descriptions. While ACC does not use these codes, a specific indicator is activated on a claim, if an injury is believed to have been self-inflicted, which is titled a wilful self-inflicted (WSI) indicator.

The table below shows the number of claims where the WSI indicator was activated, for each of the last four financial years (1 July to 30 June).

Notes on the data provided

- · Claims with a Confirmed WSI indicator are only eligible for treatment costs only
- Claims with an Inactive WSI indicator are eligible to receive financial entitlements
