OFFICIAL INFORMATION ACT REQUEST

Thank you for your email dated 20 November 2017 regarding the recent aerial 1080 operations on the Coromandel Peninsula.

You asked for Notices of Actual Discharge for Moehau, Papakai and Otahu/Mataora. You also asked for correct dates in a discharge chronology provided by you. Due to the nature of your request it has been treated as a request under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act).

In response to your request for Notices of Actual Discharge for Moehau, Papakai and Otahu/Mataora, I have attached three documents which are outlined in the table below:

Please find attached a map of the discharge area for the Otaka / Mataora 1080 Pest control operation 2017, happy to inform you this operation went very well with no issues.


The operation took place on the 19th October 2017 and took approximately 5 hours to complete.


