**Official Information Act request – Koru Club membership information**

Thank you for your email of 27 January 2018 requesting, under the Official Information Act 1982 (OIA), 'how many Air New Zealand Koru Club memberships does the Ministry of Justice have for its employees?'

The Ministry of Justice has a travel policy to ensure value for money and prudence when employees are travelling on Ministry business. Only a small number of approved employees are entitled to have airline memberships paid for by the Ministry. The Ministry pays for 38 employees to have Koru Club memberships. Ministry employees are unable to accrue airpoints when travelling on Ministry business.
