Dear Mr Ford

Thank you for your letters of 26 and 31 January 2018 and your request through the FYI website of 14 February 2018 requesting information under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act) regarding licences for stations transmitting from Titahi Bay, Porirua.

I note that you have been corresponding with Radio New Zealand, Ngā Taonga Sound and Vision, and Worksafe New Zealand to express your concerns, and that Worksafe has conducted an investigation. Those are the appropriate parties to consider safety issues.

The matters you raise are not matters within the provisions of the Radiocommunications Act 1989 and are therefore not something that can be dealt through the radio spectrum licensing regime.

You have the right to seek an investigation and review of my decision by the Ombudsman, in accordance with section 28(3) of the Act. The relevant details are:
