Please note the following:

- Reasons for terminations include students accepting other programme offers, employment commitments, family/health or other personal reasons, financial hardship and students who are not recommended for continuation.
- “total doctoral enrolments within the calendar year” refers to the total students (enrolled in the University or faculty) at any stage of a doctoral programme in a given year.
- Given extreme variation in size of faculties, the variation in percentages may not be statistically significant.
