## RESPONSE TO OVERDUE FYI.ORG.NZ REQUEST

I have today become aware that a request that you submitted through the FYI.org.nz website in 2018 was not properly allocated by my office at the time, and that you did not receive a response to your request. I apologise for this administrative error.

At the time you submitted your request to me I was the Minister of Justice. I no longer hold that role, so am unable to respond in that capacity now.

However the crux of your request was a request for legal advice ("Is the treatment of overseas contributory pensions illegal?"). Ministers are part of the Executive and are unable to give legal advice. I would encourage you to consult a lawyer when you are seeking legal advice. Notwithstanding the above, the issues you have raised more closely align with the responsibilities for the Minister for Social Development. Had your request been processed in 2018 then I likely would have transferred your request to that Minister subject to \$14(b)(ii) of the Official Information Act 1982 (the information is believed to be "more closely connected with the functions of another department... or Minister"). Given the length of time that has passed I have not transferred your request, however if you are still seeking information about this topic then you may wish to make a new request to the current Minister of Social Development, Hon Carmel Sepuloni MP, at c.sepuloni@ministers.govt.nz.
