This service provides support for Māori patients and their Whānau who are admitted to Hospital.

- Our Frontline service's role is to assist by:
- Supporting patients during their admission in hospital
- Helping the patient and Whānau understand the type of care provided by health clinicians
- Supporting clinicians and staff
- Provide in-service education to Multi Disciplinary Teams (MDT's)
- Can link patients into other hospital services that can assist/support them while they are in hospital
- Support patient and Whānau to find support from external providers
