### OFFICIAL INFORMATION REQUEST

I refer to your Official Information request of 30 May 2018 for information relating to speeding infringements. As follows is my response to each part of your request.

*1. When a speeding infringement is issued by an officer, how soon afterwards are the demerit points applied to the driver's licence;*

Demerit points are applied to a drivers licence once it is paid or is filed as an unpaid fine with the Ministry of Justice, taking into account overnight processing.

*2. When a speeding infringement is issued by a mobile speed camera van or fixed camera, are demerit points applied to the driver's licence of the registered owner;*

Demerit points are not applied to safe speed camera infringement notices.

*3. When a speeding infringement is issued by a mobile speed camera van or fixed camera, is this linked to the registered owner's driver's licence if the infringement is paid without dispute;*


All infringement notice details from safe speed cameras remain with the registered owner's traffic history, unless they transfer liability to another name.

*4. When a speeding infringement is issued by a mobile speed camera van or fixed camera, is this linked to the registered owner's driver's licence if the infringement is paid but the driver is disputed?*

Refer to the answer to question 3.

You have the right under section 28(3) of the Official Information Act 1982 to ask the Ombudsman to review my decision if you are not satisfied with the way I have responded to your request.
