OFFICIAL INFORMATION ACT REQUEST: ISRAELI COMPANIES

Thank you for your email of 4 July 2018, in which you requested, pursuant to the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act):

"...all information or communications you hold on Israeli weapons companies: Elbit Systems, Israel Aerospace Industries, Israel Military Industries Ltd. Israel Weapon Industries and RAFAEL for the period 2013-2018".

You had previously requested on 12 May 2018 all information or communications regarding these companies. On 7 June, I wrote to you suggesting you narrow the scope of your request due to the unspecified timeframe. On 12 June, you replied seeking all information for the period of 2008 to 2018. We declined your request under section 18(f) of the Act as the information requested could not be made available without substantial collation or research.

On 1 August 2018, we wrote to you advising that responding to your revised request of 4 July would still require searching a large number of files and that a significant amount of information will need to be considered and collated. Therefore, we extended the time for providing this information to 12 September 2018.

Having completed an extensive search of our files, I can now confirm that the Ministry of Defence holds no information or communications relating to Israel Military Industries Ltd and Israel Weapon Industries for the period 2013-2018.

The Ministry of Defence does, however, hold information or communications on Elbit Systems, Israel Aerospace Industries, and RAFAEL for the period 2013-2018. Listed below is a summary by company and project, and includes a description of the information and/or communications held.

As indicated in the tables above, many of the documents in the scope of your request are part of the process of completing a Request for Information (RFI) or a Request for Tender (RFT). An RFI is made during the early capability definition phase of a project. RFIs are used to collect

written information from suppliers regarding the capabilities of products, systems, and/or services, including Rough Order Magnitude Costs. RFIs put out by the Ministry of Defence are publicly available on the Government's Electronic Tender Site (GETS).

An RFT is a formal, structured invitation to suppliers to submit a bid to supply a product, system, and/or service. The resulting process would normally conclude with the identification of a preferred supplier or suppliers. RFTs put out by the Ministry of Defence are also publicly available on GETS.

While RFIs and RFTs are publicly available on GETS, the information provided by suppliers is commercially sensitive and is given to the Ministry of Defence on the basis of it being commercial in confidence. Releasing it would undermine the willingness of suppliers to provide that information, and would prejudice the Ministry of Defence's ability to carry out commercial activities. It would also prejudice or disadvantage commercial negotiations. Therefore, access to this information is declined under sections 9(2)(ba)(i) and 9(2)(i) of the Act. Where that information has been supplied by the Government of another country access is refused under section 6(b)(i).

Those documents which can be released are listed below. Where information is withheld under the Act the reason for doing so is also listed.
