- 5. What is the comparative prevalence of IPF in NZ by region?*
- 6. What is the prevalence of IPF on Waiheke Island?*
- 7. Does the NZ government do regular atmospheric testing for chemicals in the atmosphere? (If so, where is this done; and could you please provide results from the past 20 years or a link to results)?*
- 8. Does the NZ government do regular atmospheric radiation monitoring and radiation monitoring of fish? (If so, where is this done; and could you please provide results from the past 20 years, or a link to results)?*

The Ministry does not hold all of the information you have requested. However, the Ministry has been advised that the information you have requested in question 8 may be more closely associated with the functions of the the Ministry for Primary Industries.

As a result, the Ministry of Health in consultation with Ministry for Primary Industries have decided to partially transfer your request to the Ministry for Primary Industries under section 14 of the Act.

You can expect a response to your request in due course.

You have the right, under section 28 of the Act, to ask the Ombudsman to review my decision to transfer your request for information.
