**Official Information Act 1982 request – Implementation of *To Be Who I am* 2008 report**

I refer to your email of 18 July 2018 requesting, under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act), the following information:

*All papers concerning the To Be Who I Am Report written in 2008 – the year the final report was originally published.*

Your request was subsequently refined on 22 August 2018 as follows:

*“... I am seeking all reasonably significant papers, whether written for the Minister or for internal consideration.*

*I am not seeking correspondence such as letters or emails at this stage of my research...”*

A response to your request is currently being prepared. However, because the information you have requested requires consultation, a response cannot be made within the original time limit. Accordingly, we are extending the time limit for a response to the request by a further 10 working days under section 15A(1)(a) of the Act and will respond to no later than 5 October 2018.

Please be assured that we will provide a response prior to 5 October if possible.
