Please find attached my comments. I think you've done a very nice job on this and appreciate the amount of effort it took! I will be in the office on Tuesday and Wednesday next week should you have any desire to talk about my comments.

If possible, I would suggest that an industrial hygienist or environmental toxicologist review this as well. From my clinical point of view, I'd emphasize again and again that the risk of health effects at question from the types of environmental exposures being considered are poorly defined and truly based on either less weight gain in a pregnant woman or developmental effects in a mouse.
