Thank you for your information request dated 13 Here-turi-kōkā 2018. You asked for the following information:

"a copy of any advice provided by TPK with regard to the just announced Review of New Zealand Health and Disability Sector by the Labour Government.

I am particularly interested in the names/rationale/process to consider for the expert panel and its terms of reference as I am interested to know what consideration there was for Maori aspirations and ensuring a strong Maori voice additional to the equity focus that is evident.

I would also be interested in any current (2018) internal documents or communications that highlight key issues involved for Maori and the sector with regards to the review."

Your request has been considered in accordance with the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act).
