Dear K Eagan

I am writing further to your email dated 19 September 2018 requesting information regarding properties being built to accommodate disabilities for each year from 2013 to 2018 in each region.

The Official Information Act 1982 (the Act) requires that Housing New Zealand advise you of our decision on your request no later than 20 working days after the day we received your request. Unfortunately, it will not be possible to meet that time limit and we are therefore writing to notify you of an extension of the time to make our decision, under section 15(1)(b) of the Act because :

'consultations necessary to make a decision on your request are such that a proper response cannot reasonably be made within the original time limit'.

Accordingly, you can expect a response by 9 November 2018. You have the right to seek an investigation and review by the Ombudsman of this decision. Information about how to make a complaint is available at www.ombudsman.parliament.nz or by calling freephone 0800 802 602.
