Thank you for contacting Auckland Transport on 9 October 2018, requesting updates for the Papakura Safer Community Programme.

Your request for information is refused under Section 18 (d) of the Local Government Official Information and Meeting Act 1987 (LGOIMA) as the information will be publically available soon.

The feedback received in the first round of consultation will be published before the end of 2018. The next consultation phase is planned for the first half of 2019 and will focus on and outline the types of changes that will improve walkability in Papakura.

We apologise for the delay in the consultation programme, we have received a large amount of feedback that requires analysis from our project team. This analysis informs the decisions that are made regarding which areas to focus on and the types of measures we need to propose in order to meet the project objectives and reflect public feedback.

We appreciate your patience and can advise you that construction for the Papakura Safer Communities Programme is planned for the 2020/21 financial year.
