Request made under the Official Information Act 1982

Thank you for your email of 28 October 2018 requesting the following information under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act):

I request the current notified Taxi Fares for AUCKLAND and Queenstown

I am refusing your request under section 18 (e) of the Act because the document alleged to contain the information requested does not exist. As a result of legislative changes from 1 October 2017, there is no longer a legal definition of approved taxi organisations or taxis, nor for fares to be notified to the Agency, or for fares to be displayed.
