Official Information Act Request - State Sector boards and committees

Thank you for your email of 31 October 2018, requesting under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act), "a full list of all state sector boards and committees under Ministry of Justice's responsibilities", how and where vacancies are advertised, and how the public can submit their expression of interest.

I have attached a list of appointments administered by the Ministry of Justice to this reply.

As terms of appointment near their expiry dates the relevant Minister is briefed by the Ministry and provided with options regarding reappointment or appointment. Advice is also provided on how to advertise to target the most appropriate audience who may be eligible for appointment.

Many of the bodies administered by the Ministry require appointees to be barristers or solicitors. In that situation advertising is recommended in the New Zealand Law Society publication LawTalk. Some positions such as Community Magistrates or Disputes Tribunal Referees are advertised in accordance with the appropriate governing legislation. The Minister may wish to seek nominations from other Ministers, caucus colleagues, and coalition and supply party leaders.

The Minister may direct that advertising be conducted by publication in a national daily newspaper in the location in which the vacancy will exist. Other specialist positions, such as members of Land Valuation Tribunals, will be sought from nominations by the Valuers Registration Board. All vacancies, except for specialist vacancies, are published on the Ministry's website at www.justice.govt.nz/statutory-vacancies.

If you are not satisfied with my response to your request, you have the right to complain to the Ombudsman under section 28(3) of the Act. The Ombudsman may be contacted by email at info@ombudsman.parliament.nz.
