The official delegation members for the Prime Minister's visit to the United Nations General Assembly in New York in September 2018 are listed below. The official delegation was supported by staff at the New Zealand Permanent Mission to the United Nations in New York. Some names have been withheld pursuant to section 9(2)(g)(i), to protect the free and frank expression of opinions by departments, and 9(2)(g)(ii), to protect officers and employees from improper pressure or harassment.

Two hotels were used by the delegation. Ten rooms were booked in the *Fifty NYC*, and one room was booked in *The Shelburne*. One Ford Transit van was hired for the delegation.
