We have received your request from 10<sup>th</sup> December 2018 regarding information on *Stage Timing Model Summary and Background* report from 2016. We have provided a response to your queries below:

**a. Can Auckland Transport please provide a copy of the Stage Timing Model described and used in this report to produce the Appendix 6 graphs?**

The Stage Timing Model is a computer model developed by and the intellectual property of MR Cagney and is therefore not readily able to be provided as a standalone item. However, the model outputs are able to be and have been provided without needing access to the working model. This is the same situation with any computer model used by AT. We are happy to provide any of the model outputs, upon which subsequent reports are based.

**b. Can Auckland Transport please provide a copy of the "Stop Capacity Methodology" memo referred to in this report?**

There is no record of any agenda or meeting minutes being developed, and a search of AT's archived calendar system is unable to show who the attendees of that particular meeting were, but they are likely to have been representatives from AT's Metro team, Strategy & Planning division and consultants working on the light rail project, including MRCagney.

We trust the above information has addressed the matters raised however, should you believe that we have not responded appropriately to your request, you have the right in accordance with section 27(3) of the LGOIMA to make a complaint to the Office of the Ombudsman to seek an investigation and review in regard to this matter.
