The total number of applications received in January 2019 and February 2019 for each category

A guide to where each application type is currently processed

The processing totals for all branches for the months of January 2019 and February 2019 split into columns showing each branches decisions in both the residence and temporary space. If possible could it show granted vs refusal and withdraw rates."

Our Response

The statistics you have requested is attached.

Immigration New Zealand (INZ) is implementing a new operating model for Visa Services to align visa processing by product segment. The new operating model aligns visa processing to five product categories: Business, Education, Tourism, Community and Specialist. The alignment of visa processing by product category enables INZ to consolidate processing activities into fewer sites globally.

The bulk of visa applications will be processed in five offices in New Zealand (Manukau, Hamilton, Palmerston North, Porirua and Christchurch) with two large processing sites offshore in Beijing and Mumbai. There are no changes to the three offices in the Pacific at the moment. They continue to process visas of all types. By the end of December 2019, processing will have been withdrawn from 12 sites offshore and two onshore. The breakdown of the intended consolidated processing model is also attached.
