Dear Ti

Thank you for your request made under the Official Information Act, received on 1 April 2019. You requested:

*"-All advice given by the Treasury related to the May 2018 budget announcement of additional police officers.
-If the Treasury received advice from any other government department about the additional police officers, please provide me with that advice. If that is not possible, please provide me with a list of Departments/Ministries from which advice on the effects of the additional officers was obtained, the date it was received, and the title or the advice document."*

I have decided under section 15A of the Official Information Act to extend the time limit for deciding on your request by an additional 30 working days. The new due date for responding to your request is 14 June 2019.

The extension is required because of the consultations needed to make a decision on your request.

This extension will also apply to the time limit for transferring your request, should this become relevant.

Notwithstanding this extension, I undertake to make a decision on your request as soon as reasonably practicable.

You have the right to ask the Ombudsman to investigate and review this decision.
